



Round 3 2013

I had mentioned in my opening statement in the January Newsletter that "Not since Round 5 in 2010 have we had 12 club members show up to race". I can now proudly say that this is the second race meeting in almost as many months that we have had a race meet packed to the rafters with another 12 members attending. Add in one visitor (Andrew) to make 13 drivers and a top night's racing in round 3 at Chris's was the result. With four different winners in the five classes, points were difficult to come by for all drivers...

First up it was the Stock Cars on the big oval, and the big track specialists from 'Way-2-Fast' showed everyone how it is done. Alvaro streaked away in a superb display of smooth driving and avoiding other peoples prangs to record his first win at Scalextric ACT by two laps from Steve, with Stewart three laps further down in third. With two second places from two rounds, this leaves Steve on top in the points from Alvaro, Neil and Chris.

NASCAR was next, and while reigning champ Stewart missed the first round, he left no doubt he is here to defend his title in winning by one lap from Alvaro, with daylight (6 laps) back to Chris in third, narrowly edging out Neil. Chris and Alvaro are currently tied for the lead in the points, but with one win from one appearance, Stewart is clearly in the mix.

In Classic Rally, Chris made it two wins from two starts in winning by one lap from Alvaro and current champ Stewart two laps further down in third. Needless to say, Chris is the runaway leader in the points at this early stage of the season.

In SCX Rally Class, Alvaro made it two wins for the night in winning by two laps from dominant 2012 champ Chris and Neil in third. Second place in this class was a hard fought affair, with Chris, Neil and Gary all finishing on 63 laps. Chris and Alvaro are joint leaders in the pointscore, but it seems Chris might not have it all his own way in 2013.

The final class for the night was Ninco, and it was reigning champ Steve (who tied with Chris in 2012) taking the win by a lap from Stewart and then Neil who completed the same number of laps. This makes Steve a clear leader in the pointscore from Paul and Alvaro.
