



Round 4 2013

Another good roll up at Craig's for a hotly contested Round 4, and good to welcome back Mal for his first meeting since Round 5 2012.

Classic Sports was first, and in a close finish it was Alvaro on 36 laps completed edging out Neil also on 36 laps but less than a second behind. Reigning champion Chris was a clear third, with a lap in hand to the rest of the field. With first round winner Gary absent, this gives Alvaro a clear pointscore lead at this early stage of the season, with Chris second and Paul in third.

Alvaro and Neil turned it on again in Touring Cars, but this time it was Neil taking the win on 34 laps completed, one second ahead of Alvaro also on 34 laps completed. Joint-2012 champion Chris was again in third. A very closely fought class this one – four drivers finished on the same number of laps for sixth place. Chris and Alvaro are tied in the pointscore from Paul in third.

The Alvaro and Neil show continued in Classic Le Mans, with Alvaro winning by a lap on 34 laps from Neil on 33 and Steve finishing on top in a bunch of drivers all with equal laps completed for the final podium position. This means that Alvaro is a runaway leader in the pointscore after two rounds from Chris and Treasurer Dave putting in some consistent high placings to run third after two rounds.

In the LMP Class, Chris bounced back from 5th place in round 2 to take the win on 34 laps from Steve on 33 laps completed and Mal (who was back in his groove by this time) about 8 second back in third. This moves Chris to the head of the pointscore from Paul and Alvaro tied on second.

Finally it was Group C, and Alvaro managed 38 laps in taking the win, from Chris on 37 and Steve on 36. The class was so hotly contested that I think Scalextric ACT history was made when both drivers in the one heat jumped the start (Neil and Stewart) and were both penalised a lap. With two second places from two starts, this puts Chris at the head of the pointscore from Alvaro and Paul.
