



## Round 6 2013

There must be something about Neil's track that encourages close racing – this was again proven when 10 hardy souls fronted for Round 6 – the half way mark of the 2013 season. Classic Sports - Home track hero Neil notched up the first of his three victories for the night in the Classic Sports class. Alvaro holds onto his lead in the pointscore, but with a first and a second from two appearances, Neil cannot be discounted over the remainder of the season.

Touring - Neil's second victory came in Touring Cars, which he won by a lap. The battle for second was a corker, with four drivers – Alvaro, Steve, Chris and Stewart all finishing on the same number of laps – but it was Alvaro taking second beating Steve by .15! With three seconds from three starts, Alvaro 'Mr Consistency' leads in the pointscore – but with two wins from two starts, again Neil will be in the mix later in the season.

Classic Le Mans - A great tussle, with the top three drivers all on the same number of laps. It was Neil taking his third victory of the night by 4.5 seconds from Chris, and around 3 seconds further back to Stewart. Alvaro's 4th place was enough to retain his lead in the pointscore, but Chris and Neil must also rate as chances of taking the title.

LMP - The Club-supplied LMP class was next, with Chris winning by a solitary lap from Paul, who was .06 seconds ahead of Neil in third. With two wins from three starts, Chris leads the pointscore and would have to be favourite at the half way mark of the season.

Group C - Chris and Alvaro put on a great show, with Alvaro taking the win by less than 5 seconds. Neil finished a lap behind in third. This point Chris and Alvaro as joint leaders in the pointscore, and there is no doubt at this point that the winner will come from this group of two.
